- I hereby enter the above llama in the SCLA "Select" Llama Sale. All consignments must be at least 6 months old.
- Only llamas which are registered or listed will be accepted to this sale. Enclosed is my check for \$250.00 to pay the consignment fee. Make all checks payable to SCLA Select Sale. This fee is non-refundable for any reason once confirmation is made.
- Once accepted, this entry will be reserved for the sale, and in the event it is sold prior to the sale, I will pay SCLA 10% of the selling price in addition to the entry fee. A minimum commission of \$100.00 will be charged on all consignments. A \$250.00 withdrawal fee will be charged if my consignment is withdrawn from the sale for reasons other than as certified by a veterinarian. A selling fee of 10% of the amount of the highest bid received on this entry will be charged. SCLA will deduct that selling fee from the proceeds of the sale when making payment.
- I agree to pay 10% of the highest bid received whether I sell the Llama or exercise my option to have the last bid and buy back the llama. A minimum commission of \$100.00 will be charged on any lot selling for less than \$1000.00
- Once the animal has been confirmed, **no substitutions** will be allowed without prior approval from sale management.
- I have read, understand and agree to all conditions of this sale contract. I do further swear that all information furnished regarding these entries is true and correct to the best of my knowledge and that SCLA is not responsible for errors. I agree to have absolute and complete title to all llamas entered and guarantee the health of my consignments.
- Any blemishes, unsoundness, defects or irregularities of any kind must be declared and the auctioneer is hereby authorized to announce all known problems and all written guarantees. The sale management reserves the right to reject any llama that in their judgment is not up to the standard of the sale.
- ****All llamas in the sale must have a veterinarian signed certificate of health certifying the animal to be free from infection and contagious disease, as well as a negative test for TB and Brucellosis. All breeding males must be checked and certified by a DVM to have both testicles present. All females selling as pregnant must be pregnancy checked by a DVM not more than 30 days before the sale and proof of pregnancy must be turned into the sale management prior to the sale.**
- All sales constitute a contract between the buyer and seller of each animal sold. SCLA assumes no responsibility, legal or otherwise, in regard to the sale contract.
- Consignment will sell in the same order as they are listed in the catalog.
- The consignors agree to hold SCLA harmless from damages in the event that unusual or unforeseen circumstances result in the change of location, change of time or date, or cancellation of similar modification of this sale.
- All registration certificates must be signed by the legal owner or legal agent, and turned in to the sales office prior to the auction. A registration/listing application is required on unregistered crias selling with their mothers.
- It is the consignor's responsibility to feed and water their own llamas at the sale site and make sure that their llamas are brought to and shown in the sale ring and then returned to their stalls. The consignor is to furnish the buyer with a halter.
- The highest bidder will be the buyer. In case of dispute, the sole authority to settle the bid rests with the auctioneer.
- I hereby authorize SCLA to accept payment for my entries at the sale and understand that SCLA is under no responsibility to pay me for my entries until such time as the buyer has made satisfactory payment to them.
- Registration papers will be withheld by SCLA until the buyer's check clears the bank, whereupon papers will be sent directly to the buyer. The consignors will be paid by check less the commission as soon as the buyer's check clears the bank.
- All liability for statements made in the sale catalog rest with the consignor. Please check accuracy of statement with regard to winning, training, and ability of the animal.
- The sale management assumes no liability for loss or injury due to theft, mysterious disappearance, sickness, improper handling or act of God.
- Any dispute shall be resolved according to Texas law.
